# The Blessings of Serving God

Serving God is not just a duty; it is a gateway to supernatural blessings, divine honour, and kingdom promotion. Our destiny is tied to the level of our service, not our status or titles. The Bible consistently reveals that God honours those who faithfully serve Him.

## 1. Supernatural Breakthrough

Levels in the kingdom change by service. God rewards faithfulness in little things with promotion into greater responsibilities.

"And Solomon loved the Lord, walking in the statutes of his father David, except that he sacrificed and burned incense at the high places."

— 1 Kings 3:3 (NKJV)

It was Solomon's love and devotion expressed through service that set him up for wisdom and greatness. Service opens doors that prayer and titles alone cannot.

#### 2. Divine Honour

Serving God eradicates shame. When you honour Him through service, you qualify for His honour.

"The Lord your God in your midst,

The Mighty One, will save;

He will rejoice over you with gladness,

He will quiet you with His love,

He will rejoice over you with singing.

'I will gather those who sorrow over the appointed assembly,

Who are among you,

To whom its reproach is a burden.

Behold, at that time I will deal with all who afflict you;

I will save the lame.

And gather those who were driven out;

I will appoint them for praise and fame

*In every land where they were put to shame.* 

At that time I will bring you back,

Even at the time I gather you;

For I will give you fame and praise

Among all the peoples of the earth,

When I return your captives before your eyes,'

Says the Lord."

— *Zephaniah 3:17–20 (NKJV)* 

When we serve Him, He removes reproach and clothes us with honour before men.

# 3. Supernatural Enthronement

In the kingdom, you don't pray your way into positions—you serve your way into them. True enthronement is reserved for faithful servants.

"And He said to her, 'What do you wish?' She said to Him, 'Grant that these two sons of mine may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on the left, in Your kingdom.""

— Matthew 20:21 (NKJV)

Jesus taught that greatness in the kingdom comes through service, not ambition.

## **Biblical Examples:**

• **Joseph** — His faithful service in Potiphar's house and in prison paved the way for his promotion.

"And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners who were in the prison; whatever they did there, it was his doing. The keeper of the prison did not look into anything that was under Joseph's authority, because the Lord was with him; and whatever he did, the Lord made it prosper."

- Genesis 39:22-23 (NKJV)
- **David** He was a keeper of sheep, faithfully serving before God lifted him. Even after slaying Goliath, he continued to serve Saul. (1 Samuel 16:5; 17:35)
- **Daniel** His life of consistent service to God distinguished him among kings and nations.

"And when he came to the den, he cried out with a lamenting voice to Daniel. The king spoke, saying to Daniel, 'Daniel, servant of the living God, has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to deliver you from the lions?"

- Daniel 6:20 (NKJV)
- **Saul** While seeking his father's donkeys, he was found and anointed by Samuel. His enthronement began in the place of service. (1 Samuel 10)

Every throne in destiny is opened on the platform of service. When the things of God genuinely concern you, sudden lifting becomes your portion.

#### How Shall We Work the Works of God?

#### 1. Believe

Faith is the foundation of every kingdom accomplishment.

"Jesus answered and said to them, 'This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent."

— John 6:29 (NKJV)

What you do not believe, you cannot accomplish.

"...For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required; and to whom much has been committed, of him they will ask the more." — Luke 12:48 (NKJV)

"But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."

— Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV)

## 2. Pursue Your Crown through Service

Never forget that there is a crown attached to service. Cry out like Paul, "Give me grace to serve—I must not miss my crown!"

# A Growing Destiny in God

Our destiny in Christ is not static; it is progressive and ever-increasing.

"But the path of the just is like the shining sun,

That shines ever brighter unto the perfect day."

— Proverbs 4:18 (NKJV)

Refuse to be a local champion—there are higher levels in God.

"Arise and depart,

For this is not your rest;

Because it is defiled, it shall destroy,

Yes, with utter destruction."

— Micah 2:10 (NKJV)

Keep moving with God, discerning the seasons when He calls you higher. Service is the golden key to supernatural breakthrough, divine honour, and lasting enthronement.
